

Websyidian WebClient™ developed for CA Plex now released

The Websyidian WebClient™ which has been available to partners since September 2007 is now generally available. The WebClient has been developed for CA Plex in a partnership between ADC Austin and Websyidian A/S.

This new tool enables CA Plex development shops to generate HTML directly off existing CA Plex panels without development as well as deployment of new applications in a standard J2EE web server environment. The Websyidian WebClient™ also supports CA 2E applications that have been migrated to CA Plex via the ADC Modernization Studio.

The product comes with a set of advanced patterns to perform sophisticated HTML templating, enabling the development of Rich Internet Applications (RIA) that integrates seamlessly with web services and features like geo-mapping, workflow, Ajax, and RIA frameworks.

This means that the Websyidian WebClient™ handles today's web enablement challenges as well as prepares CA Plex and CA 2E applications for future challenges like SOA and sophisticated web page designs.

The WebClient has been in pilot testing with selected partners.
